## The Corporation of the Township of Atikokan By-law No. 37/04

Being a by-law to establish a policy with respect to the cutting of a second curb access to private property from municipal streets within the Township of Atikokan.

**WHEREAS** The Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, section 11(1)1 permits councils of single-tier municipalities to pass by-laws with respect to the use of highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

**WHEREAS** the Corporation of the Township of Atikokan has occasionally received requests for the cutting of second curbs access from municipal streets to private properties; and

**WHEREAS** Council deems it necessary to prescribe a policy which addresses this situation.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council for the Corporation of the Township of Atikokan ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- Applications for second cuts will be submitted to the Director of Public Works
- 2. The Director of Public Works will approve and recommend the second cut based on conflicts with existing and future utilities and from a safety and drainage perceptive.
- 3. All labour, material and equipment necessary for cutting the second access shall be provided by The Corporation of the Township of Atikokan.
- 4. The actual cost of the work will be 100% recoverable from the property owner.
- 5. Prior to commencement of the construction under this by-law the property owner shall deposit with the Treasurer funds based on the estimate of the cost of the work as determined by the Township of Atikokan
- 6. Any unused portion of the deposit will be refunded to the property owner and any cost in excess of the estimate will be invoiced to the property owner.

And further t	that by-law	#80-88 is	hereby	repealed.
