COVID-19 UPDATE and Service Disruptions #12

The Government of Ontario has announced that as of June 30, 2021 the province will move to Step 2 of the Roadmap to Reopen.

As of Monday, July 5, 2021, the Atikokan Municipal Office will open to foot traffic.

To protect staff, visitors are not permitted to access individual offices and all interactions with Town staff will take place at the front counter unless an appointment has been made in advance. For general inquiries, we continue to encourage the public to call 597-1234 or use the staff directory available on our website (www.atikokan.ca/content/town-contacts-0) to contact the appropriate staff member via email.

To allow for social distancing, only 5 people may enter the lobby at a time. Those entering the building will be required to complete a self-assessment posted on the front door. We ask that you respect social distancing and use the hand sanitizer provided. Hours of operation remain Monday to Friday, 8:30 am – 4:30 pm.

Council meetings will continue to be held virtually until further notice, for more information please contact the Clerks Department.

As of Wednesday, June 30, 2021, the following outdoor recreation facilities are open:

- Outdoor sports leagues (i.e slowpitch and outdoor fitness classes can resume.
- Bunnell Park is open for recreational camping. Please visit letscamp.ca/camps/bunnell-park-campground to book.
- The Summer Playground program will begin July 6, 2021 at the Hemlock Outdoor Recreation Centre.
- The Specialized Transit Vehicle (Handi-Van) will remain open as usual

All indoor recreation facilities including the Pool, Pioneer Centre and Little Falls Recreation Centre remain closed at this time.

As of 12:00 pm Tuesday, July 6, 2021, the Atikokan Public Library will be opening at 25% capacity. Face masks are required, please continue to return all books to the outdoor book drop.
