COVID-19 UPDATE and Service Disruptions #7

As Ontario enters a province-wide lockdown, and in the interest of safety for all residents, the Town of Atikokan enacts the following:

- **Town Hall will be closed to foot traffic effective 11:30 am on December 24, 2020 with a planned opening of Monday, January 11, 2021.**
- All emergency and essential services will continue with normal operations. For Public Works emergencies please call 597-2135.
- On regular business days (not including Christmas Day, Boxing Day (observed) or New Years Day), citizens can still contact Town Staff Monday through Friday 8:30 am to 4:30 pm at 807-597-1234 and leaving a message or by emailing us directly using the directory located on our website (www.atikokan.ca).
- Property tax and water/sewer payments can still be made at your banking institution, through on-line banking, tele-banking, or by mail. Payments and correspondence can also be dropped off using the mailbox located beside the main doors at Town Hall. To sign up for automatic withdrawal or for help setting up on-line banking, please contact the Finance department at 807-597-1234 extension 225 and leave a message or email (info@atikokan.ca)
- **All indoor recreation facilities including the Pool, Arena, Little Falls Recreation Centre, and the Pioneer Centre are closed effective December 26th 12:01 a.m. until further notice.**
- Outdoor rinks will remain open; however, the warming shacks will be closed until further notice. All provincial guidelines for social distancing and gathering limits must be followed.
- All other Municipally owned outdoor facilities (playgrounds, ski trails, etc.) remain open, subject to provincial guidelines.
- Atikokan Public Library will open for curbside pick up starting Tuesday, January 5th with service on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursdays from 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Centennial Museum will be closed until further notice.
- Specialized Transit is running with modified Holiday Hours. Hours are posted on our social media page and posted at Town Hall.
